What is the most expensive city in the world?
 According to a study on the cost of living worldwide, Singapore gets to keep the title it earned the year before.

It's no surprise for the city's high prices for clothes and cars. On its tail are Paris, Oslo, Zurich, and Sydney, and rounding out the top ten are Melbourne, Geneva, Copenhagen, Hong Kong and Seoul. Basically, the top five spots are the same as last year.

In 11th place is London. The UK city is now as expensive as the world's most expensive city two years ago, Tokyo. If you are wondering about New York City, even though it is in the 22nd, it is still the most expensive city in the US. Interestingly, both Sydney and Melbourne were cheaper than New York City ten years ago. However, thanks to Australia's stronger dollar and increased cost of living, the two cities have moved up their rankings.

Lady Gaga won the Oscar for Best Original Song, for the song "Shallow" from *A Star Is Born*, and her speech left not a single dry eye in the house.

"If you are at home and you're sitting on your couch and you're watching this right now, all I have to say is this is hard work", she began, with tears beginning to fall. **"I have worked hard for a long time and it's not about winning. What it's about is not giving up. If you have a dream, fight for it. There's a discipline for passion: it's not about how many times you get rejected or you fall down and get beaten up, but how many times you stand up, and are brave and you keep on going."**

As for her on-screen love Bradley Cooper? She had special words for him as well. "There is not a single person on the planet that could have sung this song with me but you," she said. "Thank you for believing in us, thank you so much."

Gaga has come a long way to get to this point. "I used to wrap myself in a blanket and stand on a podium while I watched the Oscars," Gaga told "Variety" in 2018. "I had big dreams as a child."

We love you, Gaga. Thank you for keeping it real!
