





In the world today, over 7,000 languages are still alive and spoken(說). 23 of them have at least 50 million speaker. What's more, 4.1 billion people have one of those 23 languages as their first language.

Even so, reports show that about one language died every two weeks. An example of this is Wik Mungkan. It is one of the languages still spoken(說) by the native people of Australia. There were once over 250 languages, but now only about 120 are still used, with 13 of them spoken by all age groups. Just like with the native people of North America, the children of the native(土著的) people of Australia grow up learning and speaking only English.

The charts below show some of the changes in the Wik Mungkan language from 2004 to 2014. From the first one, we can see that the number of speakers dropped by nearly one-third. Then, in the table(表格), those speakers used the language less in their daily lives. If nothing is done(做) to stop this soon, we may all be seeing the end of another language.


If you are planning on having a pleasant(令人愉快的) meal with the whole family at a Sugar Factory for Thanksgiving, you had better pick a different restaurant chain(連鎖店). Cases(案例) of the deadly stomach bug have reached three new states, and it doesn't look like they are going to stop anytime soon. This brings the count up from six states to nine. The first cases were reported in the northern states of Devon and Grant at the end of October. So far 55 people have come down with the bug(病菌), and 52 of them said they had eaten at a Sugar Factory a week before they got sick. That was not good news for the chain because it had to close 43 restaurants in those states(州) alone.


The Center for Public Health says that the bug first spread(蔓延) south and then east. Now, seven more people in the middle states have come down with the bug and are in the hospital fighting for their lives. If just one of them kicks the bucket, that could mean the end of the line for the Sugar Factory.




