

The cat statue is the famous Maneki-neko, a lucky thing from Japan. It is often believed that the Maneki-neko, or the lucky cat in English, brings good luck to people who own it.

Maneki-neko comes in different colors. White, black, and gold are the most common. Each means differently. White brings good luck, black gives good health and keeps bad things away, and gold invites money. You might even find a pink Maneki-neko, which is for those who want love.

There are different stories about the <u>origin</u> of this lucky cat. One goes like this. A long time ago in Japan, one day, as a king and his friends passed by a shabby temple, they saw a cat waving at them at the gate. Then they went in and met a monk, who owned the cat. The monk gave them tea to drink and talked to them. During the talk, the king was happy to learn some wise life lessons. He then gave the temple large pieces of land to grow rice. The rice brought the temple a lot of money. For people to remember the cat for bringing in the good luck, after it died, its statue with a raised paw was built. That was the first Maneki-neko.
