


People from different countries have different pictures of fingers. Even the same gesture in different countries have different meanings.

For example, in American and European cultures, a thumbs-up sign is a symbol of "well-done." In Brazil, they don't use an "OK" gesture. Because they think it is not polite. So how do Brazilians say agree with a hand gesture? They will give you a thumbs-up sign. However, in Egypt, a thumbs-up sign has the same meaning as the Taiwanese middle finger standing alone. So, it would be very rude if you do so.


In Germany, counting one starts with the thumb. So, if you need to order one cup of coffee in the German coffee shop, you need to show a thumb, not a <u>pointer finger</u> in our common knowledge.

Next time, before you take a trip, remember the words, "When in Rome, do as the Romans do." Try to know more about each country's special gestures, or using wrong gestures in wrong places will lead to lots of trouble.




