I.

Hollywood producer and actor Tyler Perry expressed concern over the potential job losses in the film industry due to artificial intelligence (AI). He shared a personal experience illustrating this concern, explaining that he had postponed an \$800 million studio expansion project to assess the impact of AI. Perry emphasized the need for regulations to safeguard against AI's effects, stating,

"There's got to be some sort of regulations in order to protect us from AI. If not, I just don't see how we survive."

Perry mentioned OpenAI's text-to-video tool, Sora, as a specific example that influenced his decision to delay his studio project. Sora, named after the Japanese word for sky, generates videos up to one minute in length based on user prompts or photos, showing its creative potential. While Perry admitted AI's usefulness in filmmaking, he remained concerned about its potential to displace jobs across the industry, including actors and editors. He said, "It makes me worry so much about all of the people in the business... I'm thinking this will touch every corner of our industry."
