Euphemisms are words we use that are thought more pleasant than direct speech. Many westerners use them, as above, to talk about products some people might find controversial, such as alcohol. Alcohol, after all, can have harmful effects. So, in the above example, rather than saying directly, “I’m going out to drink beer,” the friend uses “adult beverages” instead of “beer” to express politely.

Euphemisms are also used to talk about subjects people might find uncomfortable. For instance, it would be quite a shock to hear somebody say “My father died.” So, to make the subject sound softer, and put some compassion behind it, North Americans, or the British, often use the phrase “pass away” to refer to someone’s death.

Although using euphemisms is not a must when you speak, it does make you sound educated and can avoid offending people. If you want to leave others with a good impression, try to use euphemisms rather than direct speech when you are holding a conversation with others.
