
Secondly, Wanggong in Changhua offers a wide variety of oyster dishes 25. their famous oyster-farming industry.

Duty: working at a great height on scaffolding for long hours, even on hot sunny days


Risk: Heavy equipment and sharp tools can cause harm during construction. About one third of the occupational deaths in this industry result from slips and falls.

Risk: Fighting crime and handling emergencies, they put their lives under the threat of people with bad intentions. Being injured or even killed on purpose is the risk they have to face every day.



Waste collector

Duty: keeping streets clean, handling smelly materials, recycling waste

Risk: The deaths and injuries in this industry are mostly transportation related because they need to jump on and off a moving truck. The spill of harmful substances may also make them infected or sick.



Fishermen

Duty: laboring with enormous fishing nets and heavy equipment to fish on open waters.

Risk: When any accident occurs, medical assistance is not readily available. In addition, drowning is the leading cause of death since the weather condition on the sea is unpredictable.
