Riddles have been a popular interest that people all over the world have enjoyed for hundreds of years. Many people say that the earliest riddles were shown as messages from God. In old times, riddles were mainly about the sun, the moon, the rainbow and the wind. Homer, a Greek poet, had died of the accident. He tripped and died when he guessed the answer to the riddle which was asked by several boys. Although it was a legend, we can know that he was interested in riddles.

What is a riddle? A riddle is a word puzzle in which one player asks a confusing question, and the other player has to figure out its meaning. In other words, one player gives **ambiguous** words, and the other player must know that one of the words is used in a surprising or clever way to solve it. The surprising answer always makes the players laugh. Homophone riddles are two or more words we make the same sound. They have different spellings and meanings. For example, the question is “What’s black and white and *red* all over?” The answer is “A newspaper!” In fact, there are no fixed rules when we play the riddle game. Are you ready to begin?

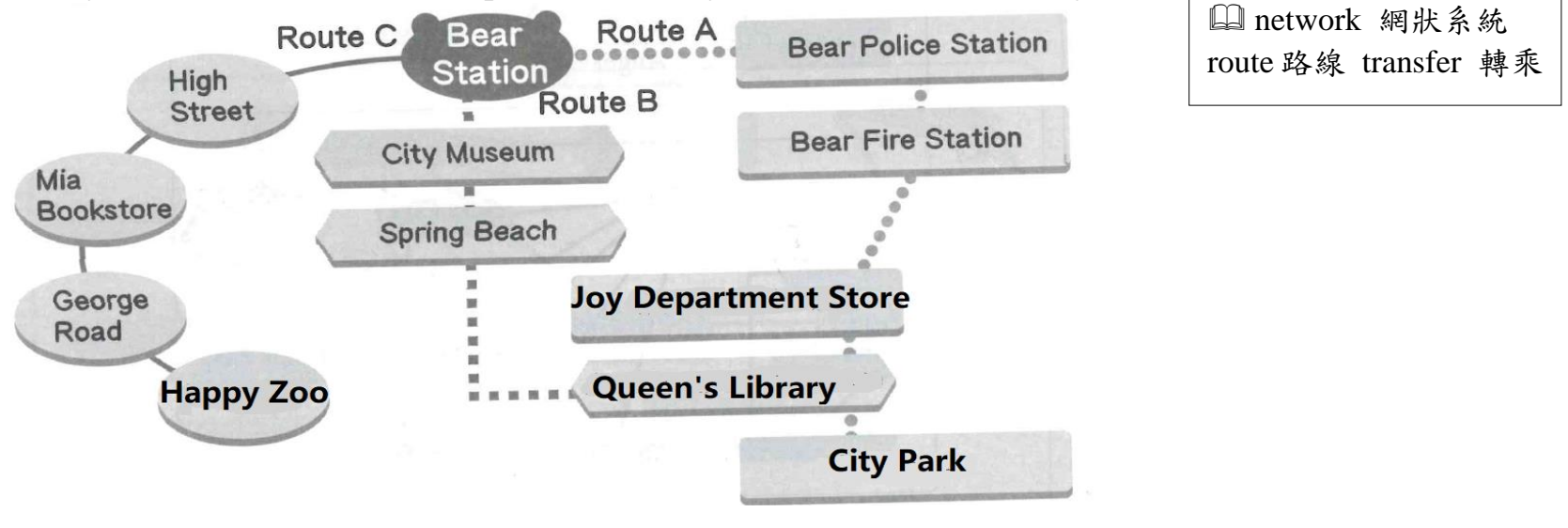

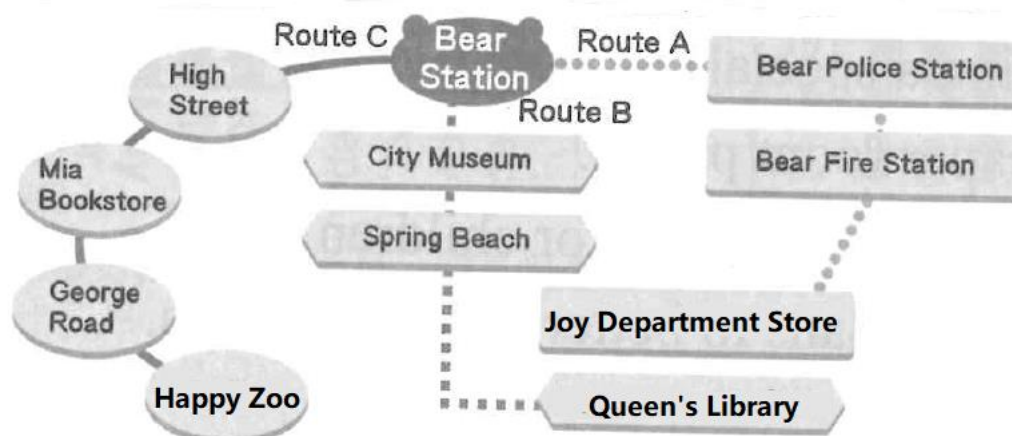
From March 1st, Bear Town will have a new bus network with more buses, to more places in town. Here are some new changes for Bear Bus.

1. **Route A**, which runs between Bear Station and City Park, will stop at two more stops, Joy Department Store and Queen's Library. The first bus will run at 5:15 a.m. on weekdays and at 5:30 a.m. on weekends after March 1st.
2. **Route B**, which runs between Bear Station and Queen's Library, will not stop at Joy Department Store from March 1st. Those who want to get to Joy Department Store will have to transfer to Route A at Queen's Library. Route B will change its last bus from 9 p.m. to 10 p.m. every day after March 1st.
3. **Route C**, a new route, will begin to run between Bear Station and Happy Zoo from March 1st. It will stop at High Street, Mia Bookstore, and George Road. The buses will run between 5:20 a.m. and 11 p.m. from Monday to Friday, and between 7 a.m. and 8 p.m. on Saturday. It will not run on Sunday.

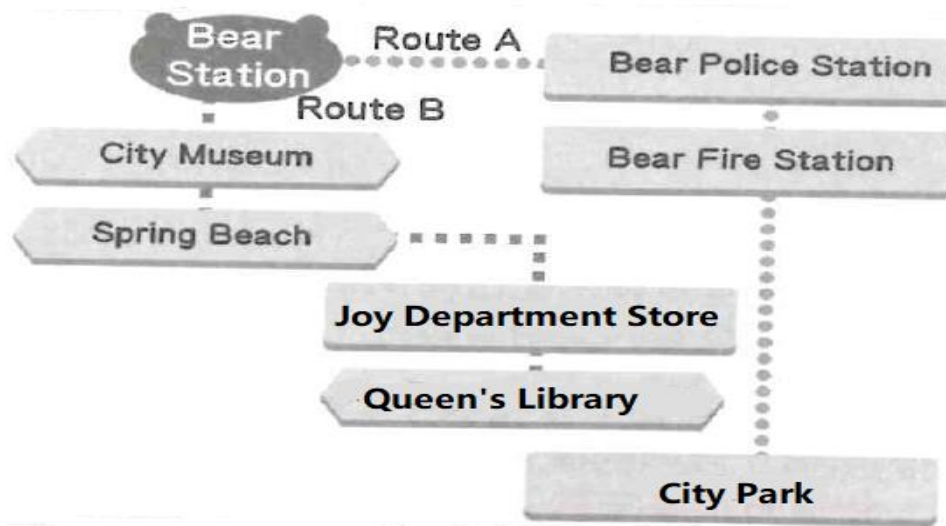

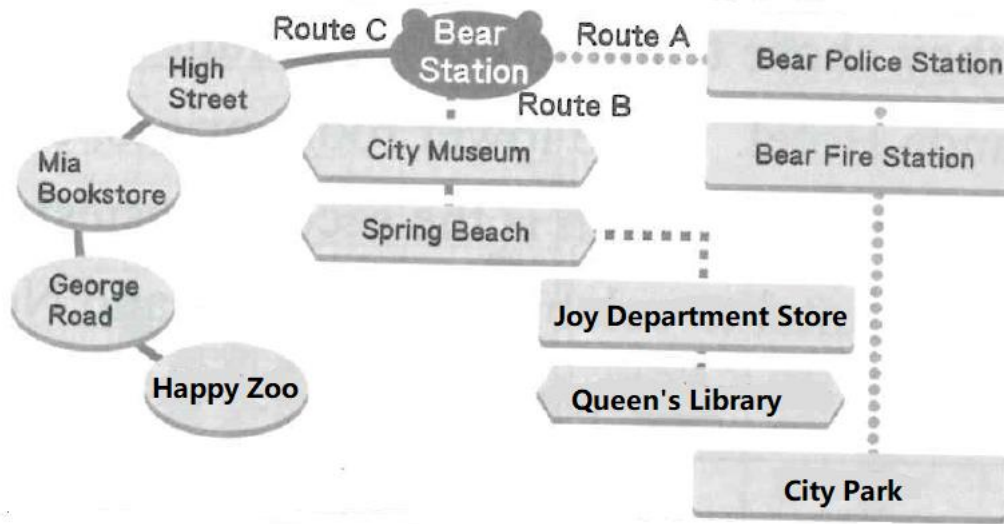
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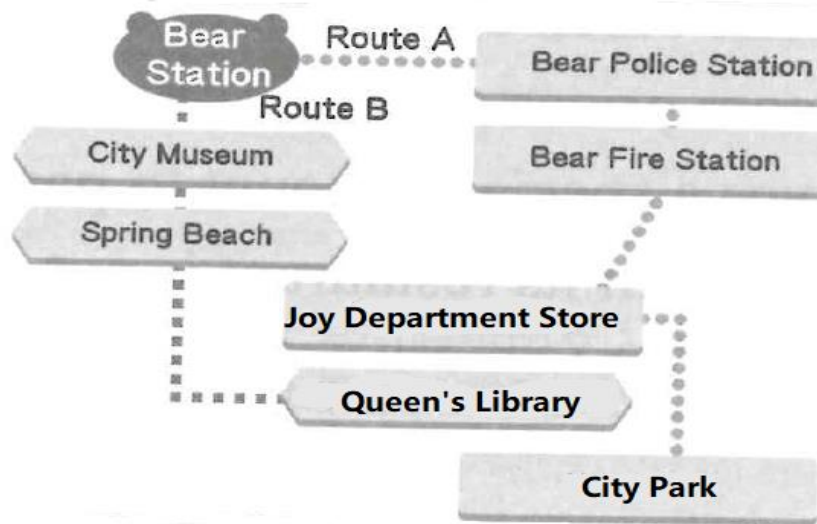
